4 SCOPE AND SCOPE SPECIFICATION OF ACCREDITATION

4.1 SCOPE OF ACCREDITATION

The scope of accreditation is a general definition of activities of an organization, accredited or seeking accreditation for.

The scope of accreditation of EV represents the performance of verification of environmental statements and of environmental management systems and audit according to Regulation (EC) No 1221/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council, amended by Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/1505 and Commission Regulation (EU) 2018/2026.

4.2 SCOPE SPECIFICATION OF ACCREDITATION/SPECIFICATION OF ACTIVITIES

The scope specification of accreditation is a detailed description of activities for the performance of which an organization is accredited.

The specification of activities is a range of activities for which an organization seeks accreditation and which in form is identical with the scope specification of accreditation.

The scope specification of accreditation of EV is defined according to the classification of economic activities (NACE codes) set by the Regulation (EC) No 1893/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council. The scope specification of accreditation is limited by the technical competence of EV.

The scope specification of accreditation is expressed as a table (Annex 1) consisting of all activities for which the EV may be accredited and it is processed in accordance with the document IAF ID 1: 2014, Issue 2.

In the case that EV has more workplaces where verification activities are performed, under the table with the scope accreditation shall be stated the following:
