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
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1 Introduction

This methodical guideline defines the procedure for witness assessment of environmental verifiers (hereinafter, EV) according to ISO/IEC 17021-1: 2015 and Regulation (EC) No 1221/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council, amended by Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/1505 and Commission Regulation (EU) 2018/2026. This methodical guideline is obligatory for employees of the accreditation body and applicants for accreditation.

4 WITNESS ASSESSMENT PROCEDURE

The witness assessment is an integral part of accreditation process, which monitors and evaluates the procedure of the members of the EV team during the verification.

The assessment group (hereinafter, PS) evaluates the preparation for performance of verification, performance of verification and assesses overall course of performance of verification, including efficiency and the way of its performance, as well as compliance with the documented procedures, regulations and standards during the verification.

The nonconformities identified by the assessment group are recorded and addressed in the AIS information system.

After conducting a witness assessment, the lead assessor hands over to the head of the EV team the SNAS report on findings in printed form, with a brief summary of the results. A report is then prepared from the witness assessment.

5 WITNESS ASSESSMENT REPORT

From the witness assessment a Witness assessment report is elaborated, in which the course of the verification is assessed and its compliance with valid regulations of the EV, documented in its documentation.

Witness assessment report contains:

- the number of accreditation service, number of the registered member of the EV, number of the accreditation certificate of the EV,
- standard and regulation, according to which the assessment is carried out,
- the names and surnames of the members of the PS and their functions,
- the name and address of the applicant of the EV, the name and address of the workplace of the EV
- the date of execution of witness assessment,
- type of accreditation service, which is the witness assessment part,
- item of the scope of accreditation, witness assessed team of environmental verifier, the name and address of the organization,
- evaluation:
- the preparatory phase preparation for performance of verification (programme of verifications; allocation of time; verification plan; the appointment of the team of environmental verifier; communication with the client organization),
- performance of the verification the opening of the verification (opening; explanation of the course of verification), allocation of tasks (compliance with the plan of the verification; the performance of the tasks of the individual members of the team of environmental verifier; keeping records), verification (verification of the organisation's compliance with the requirements of the Regulation environmental review (according to the Annex I to the Regulation), environmental management system (Annex II), internal environmental audit (Annex III), environmental reporting/statement (Annex IV), verification of the organization's compliance with all applicable legal requirements relating to the environment, the organisation's continuous improvement of environmental performance, the reliability, credibility and correctness of the data and information in the environmental statement and environmental information; concluding on the findings of verification), the termination of the verification (notice of verification results; information about the next steps; conclusion),



- the efficiency and way of performance of verification (adherence to the plan of the verification; the skills, the consistency, the presentation skills of the individual members of the team of environmental verifier), compliance with documented procedures/regulations/standards during the verification,
- overall a positive and a negative site, suggestions for improvement, the number of identified and eliminated nonconformities, the conclusion (the competence of the individual members of the team of environmental verifier in relation to the listed item of the scope of accreditation).

6 GROUPS OF ECONOMIC ACTIVITIES FOR WITNESS ASSESSMENT

The individual economic activities defined by the EA/NACE codes are divided into 9 groups of related activities (Annex 1). The number of witness assessments is determined by performing one witness assessment for each group and at least one critical EA/NACE code from that group. For groups with a number of EA/NACE codes greater than five, further witness assessment is performed for each of the next five EA/NACE codes in the group.

During the accreditation, at least one witness assessment is performed for each EA/NACE group of codes.

During the re-accreditation, the witness assessment is performed for each EA/NACE group of codes except for those that have been witnessed in the accreditation cycle.

During the extension of accreditation scope, the witness assessment is carried out as for accreditation and in the range of activities that are the subject of extension.

During the surveillance, the witness assessment is carried out for each EA/NACE group of codes and in the range of activities that are the subject of surveillance.
